THIS MONTH'S PRESENTATION

This month's presentation will be given by Bill Tisdale, member of the FAA Safety Team (FAASTeam), and member of the Las Vegas Valley Soaring Association. Bill is a glider instructor with the LVVSA and is very knowledgeable about the very congested airspace south and southwest of HND. His presentation is titled, "Local Airspace Flight Safety: How Not To Be A 'Near Miss' Target." Bill will discuss:

- The impact of airspace congestion with all of the Airline, Corporate and General Aviation aircraft in the southern Las Vegas Ivanpah Valley, Jean airport area.
- Congestion of general aviation traffic below and around the Las Vegas Class B airspace.
- Sailplane operations around the Las Vegas area, specifically in the Jean area.
- Multi-use airport operations at the Jean Airport, including expected traffic pattern operations and frequency congestion.
